## COMPETITION RULES

This document sets out the terms and conditions of entry and participation in “The Perfect shot Hole in One” competition (“the **Competition**”).

By submitting an entry and making payment for such entry into the Competition, each and every participant agrees to and shall be bound by these terms and conditions.

### Definitions:

- (a) “Hole in One” – means the first shot that enters the designated hole from the designated tee with no intervening shots;
- (b) Participant – means the person who enters the “Hole in One” competition and attempts a Hole in One.
- (c) The Designated hole – means the Par 3 hole at the Golf Club.
- (d) Round of Golf – means 9 or 18 holes of golf played in a given order, each hole is played only once in a round and per day
- (e) Golf Course / Golf Club – means the Golf course where the Participant has entered the Competition and where the Competition will take place.
- (f) The Prize Fund – means the prize for winning the Competition shall be the amount of money held in The Golf Club’s Prize Fund from time to time.
- (g) Owner - means the owner and creator of the Competition being FLOOID (Pty) Ltd.

### Eligibility:

Entry into the Competition is open to golfers who are;

- (a) Over the age of 18
- (b) Non-Professional golfers
- (c) Registered and paid for a Round of Golf at the Golf Course

### Competition Period:

- (a) The Competition will run daily for the duration of the Golf Course’s trading hours and a new competition shall begin the next day. For avoidance of doubt, a Participants entry shall only be valid for the specific round of golf it has booked, paid and registered for on that day of entry.
- (b) The Owner reserves the right to suspend, cancel or amend the Competition and/or revise these terms and conditions at any time without giving prior notice to the Participants. By continuing to take part in the competition subsequent to any revision of these terms and conditions, participants shall be deemed to have agreed to any such new or amended terms. We will endeavour to avoid any disappointment or any disadvantage to those who have already entered. The updated terms and condition will be available on the FLOOID and the Golf Course’s official website or on request.

### Competition Rules:

- (a) To win the Competition, a participant must score a Hole in One.
- (b) All daily Participants shall be entered into the Competition of the day. If more than one participant achieves a Hole-in-one on the day, the daily prize money will be split equally amongst all confirmed and eligible winners.
- (c) To be deemed a valid entry the participant must be registered to play a Round of Golf.
- (d) Only one attempt at the hole is permitted from the respective club tee markers setup for both ladies and men on the day and no practice shots, preferred lies or any other alteration to conditions are allowed.
- (e) Mulligans may not be used to achieve the “Hole in One” prize.
- (f) Participants are limited to one entry per round of golf per day.

- (g) The daily “Hole in One” competition entry fee is R20
- (h) Entry and payment must be made prior to playing the designated hole.
- (i) If the participant specifies an incorrect entry day/date in error, the date that has been specified will be deemed to be the date of entry.
- (j) Payment must be made using a credit or debit card, or by cash.
- (k) There must always be a minimum of two participants entering the “Hole in One” competition at the same tee time for the “Hole in One” to be deemed valid.
- (l) FLOODID accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed, illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence whether due to error, omission, alteration, tampering, deletion, theft, destruction or otherwise.
- (m) Winners must notify the Golf Club, by close of business on that day, of their claim and video footage will be viewed to verify and confirm qualifying participants.
- (n) A “Hole in One” will only be deemed valid if clearly captured as such on the putting green surveillance camera and shall be determined in the Golf Course and/or FLOODID’s sole discretion
- (o) If, for any reason, there is any interference or disruption in the conduct or operation of the Competition, (including but not limited to power or technical failure, natural disasters, acts of God, pandemic or epidemic computer viruses etc). FLOODID reserves the right to suspend, cancel, terminate, modify or recommence the Competition (as applicable), where required.
- (p) The Owner or the Golf Course will not be liable for any losses to any party arising from any variation or cancellation of the Competition.
- (q) A claim shall for example, be deemed to be invalid and the daily entry fee will be refunded if:
  - i. The cameras do not capture the “Hole in One” with sufficient clarity for a decision to be taken (for example, inclement weather such as mist or rain that prevents the cameras from clearly capturing the “Hole in One”); or
  - ii. The cameras fail to operate properly for whatever reason.
- (r) In the event of a participant achieving a “Hole in One”, the participant must present identification matching the name entered on the entry form and must also match the person achieving the “Hole in One” on the surveillance cameras.
- (s) If a claim is deemed valid the prize money will be paid by EFT, into a bank account nominated by the Participant, within 7 days of the winner being eligible and verified.
- (t) FLOODID reserves the right to disqualify or reject any entries that, in our sole and absolute discretion, we determine do not meet the Competition criteria set out in these Terms and Conditions.

#### PRIZEFUND

Prize money is determined at the discretion of FLOODID and is displayed on the entry form on the day.

- a) All amounts are quoted in SA Rands and are inclusive of VAT.
- b) The Prize Fund shall be a minimum of R10 000.00 on any given day.
- c) The prize fund value will be updated every Monday after 18:00 unless there is a winner then the fund will be updated at the end of that business day.
- d) FLOODID accepts no responsibility for any financial or other legislative implications arising from acceptance and/or payment of any prize fund.

#### PRIVACY

- a) The Golf Club will collect the personal information provided by a Participant for the purpose of conducting the Competition and contacting the Participant should they win the Competition.
- b) Video footage from the surveillance camera will only be downloaded, viewed and saved for the purpose of confirmation and eligibility of a claim in establishing a winner.
- c) FLOODID and the Golf Course shall comply with all the relevant requirements as set out in the Protection of Personal Information Act.

## GOVERNANCANDSEVERABILITY

These Competition Terms are subject to the laws of GOLF RSA. Any disputes will be governed by and subject to mediation and the laws of this association

FLOOID will not be liable for any loss (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss), damage or personal injury which is suffered or sustained (including without limitation to that caused by any person's negligence) relating to this Competition, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case liability is limited to the minimum amount allowable by law).
